

## **SWAC Meeting**

### **Minutes for February 3, 2014**

The South Winneshiek Advisory Committee met on February 3, 2014 at 5:45 p.m., with 13 members present. Marcia Kruse was also in attendance.

School Calendar: Mr. Hoover presented the proposed calendar for the 2013/2014 school year. He explained the idea of counting hours versus counting days. He noted all early dismissal days have a 1:00 pm dismissal time, with the exception of homecoming.

Learning Goals: High School Learning goals

Reading Grade 10: 88% or 52 students out of 59 will be proficient in reading.

Grade 11: 88% of 46 students out of 52 will be proficient in reading.

Math Grade 10: 95% or 56 students out of 59 will be proficient in math.

All percentages are based on cohort groups and require three non-proficient students to move to proficiency.

Barb explained the elementary / middle school SINA action plan.

Projected Enrollment: Mr. Hoover also presented the projected enrollment for the next ten years. This data is based on the county birth rate and current class sizes. South Winn, like most school districts, is looking at a declining enrollment. Mr. Hoover spoke on the importance of allowable growth to help offset the decline.

Discussion was also held on the policy on make up days.
