  - A. [ACT information](#) – Mrs. Euans
    1. The five-year trend of the district's ACT results were shared. The SWCSD has consistently scored above the state-wide average in most subject areas. The scores were English: Local - 20.2, State - 20.8; Math: Local - 23.8, State - 21.0; Reading: Local - 23.2, State - 22.3; Science: Local - 22.7, State - 21.8; Composite: Local - 22.6, State - 21.6. Prior to the school-year test dates in October, December, February and April, Mrs. Emery provides tutoring on the ACT during advisory.
  - B. [Certified Enrollment](#) – Mr. Einck
    1. The District's Certified Enrollment, based on students in the district on October 1, 2019 was 461.78 in Fall 2018 and 487.67 in Fall 2019. The District had a student increase of 25.89 students. A majority of the new students are at the elementary level.
  - C. [Emergency Operations Plan](#) (OEP) – Mrs. Hemesath

1. The District's Emergency Operation Plan (EOP) was reviewed. Major changes in the plan included the addition of the "Run, Fight, Run" component. Other components included in the EOP include: Evacuation and Reunification, Run, Hide, Fight, Fire, Tornado, Sudden Death of Student/Staff, Pandemic Flu, Bomb Threat, etc. Building changes included the addition of exterior door numbers, replacement of interior locks and the addition of Reunification Kits. The program, "I Love You Guys", was added as a District resource. The administration will schedule various drill practices for students and staff throughout the school year.

  1. Student presentations have been scheduled on various topics i.e. Camfel presentations, vaping, bullying, etc. They will be presented on various topics throughout the school year.
